April 11, 2006

Board Meeting

April 18, 2006

- Sporting Clays committee members John Jacobson, Vince Lori and Rich Pelt where present to provide details of operating procedures and costs.
- John Jacobson discussed the sporting clays course layout and the cash donations from members for water jugs, benches for each shooting station and some road materials.
- Discussed the commercial loan details and repayment schedule to the Recreation Center. The Recreation Center will secure the loan of \$180,000.00 (\$90,000.00 current loan balance and an additional \$90,000.00 to finance the Sporting Clay project)
- Motion approved - that the association will guarantee the repayment of the loan from the Recreation Center by paying a monthly lease fee of \$2900.00 to the Recreation Center to cover the loan payment and property taxes.
- Joe informed the Board members that only \$2000 of the 300 Club Raffle money has been turned in at this time. The intent is to provide extra cash to purchase a Doubles Trap Machine at a cost of \$8000.00.
- Motion passed to order the doubles trap machine prior to the first scheduled ATA shoot on May 21st.
- Motion passed to purchase 15 club shooting vests @ a cost of \$50.00 each to be worn by shooters representing our Club at events.
- Motion passed - 1opposed - to comp the Membership dues for the "Member of the Year" and for the "Long term Distinguished Member of the Year.
- Motion passed to purchase a replacement tractor for the Ford in the price range of \$2800.00 to \$3500.00.
- Motion passed to have a three gun raffle called "The Huntsmen Raffle"
- Approved - Jay Grunner would like to bring his food wagon to the Sunday Shoot, to try it out, all profits will go to the club
- Carole Lievens would like to have a meeting with all the women of H.P.S.A. on May 18th to Discuss more activates for female members.
