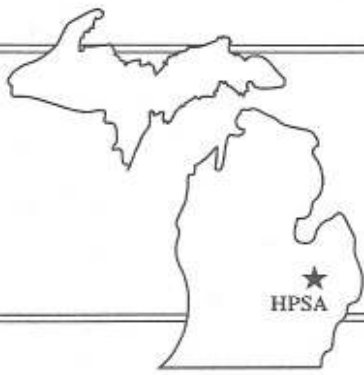

PROPOSED BY LAW CHANGES REQUIRED TO OBTAIN A CLUB LIQUOR LICENSE

ARTICLE III

PART 1: MEMBERSHIP

Section 1:

All members must be ~~eighteen (18)~~ twenty one 21 years of age or over to receive voting rights on alcohol related issues.

Or - add to existing – “Members under 21 years of age may not vote on any alcohol related issues”

Section 3: **ADD** section

Membership Definitions:

I: Officers/Directors: EboD, Executive Board of Directors, (as defined in Article V, section 1); Full voting rights on all club issues that require membership approval. Dues waived while in office. Participate in club events at GM rates. Elected to office at the December GMM by nomination, ballot and majority vote. Assuming office on January 1.

II: Directors: BoD (as defined in Article V, section 1); Full voting rights on all club issues that require membership approval. Dues waived while in office. Participates in club events at GM rates. Elected to office at the December GMM by nomination, ballot and majority vote. Assuming office on January 1.

III: Green and Gold: A member who has reached the age of sixty (60) and has been a H.P.S.A. member in good standing for fifteen (15) consecutive years. Shall be exempt from paying dues and special assessments and will retain full voting rights on all club issues that require membership approval (1 vote per member of record). Pays an annual maintenance fee (as defined in Article III, Part II, Section 4). Participates in club events at GM rates.

IV: General Member: A member in good standing (as defined in Article III, Part I, Section 10) has full voting rights (1 vote per member of record) Pays membership dues (as defined in Article III, Part II). Participates in events at GM rates.

V: Probationary Member (First year as GM): A Probationary member has full voting rights on all club issues that require membership approval (1 vote per member of record) Pays membership dues (as defined in Article III, Part II, Section 6) and meets requirements (as defined in Article III, Section 6 and Section 7) Participates in club events at GM rates. Is ineligible to run for any board position (can be waived with a 2/3 vote of the GM)

VI: Wait List: A prospective member that has met all requirements (as defined in these By-Laws) will remain on the wait list (maximum number of applicants shall not exceed fifty (50), (openings are filled on a first come first serve interview process,). Furthermore has no voting rights, participates in events at non- member rates. No person on the wait list may purchase alcohol at the club.

VII: Inactive Member: A member who has paid a fee (as defined in Article III, Part II, Section 5) Has no voting rights. Participates in club events, at non-member rates. May be reinstated (as defined in Article III, Part II, Section 5). Inactive member may not purchase alcohol at the club.

Section 4: 5

Prospective members must remain on the waiting list (Maximum Limited to 50 on list) if the club roster is full. The H.P.S.A. BoD will determine the cost of these annual fees.

Section 7: 9

Guest (s) All members must sign in all guests. The sponsoring Member (s) will also be responsible for their guest(s) during their visit to H.P.S.A. No guest may purchase alcohol at the club.
