February 13, 2006

- Progress was reported on the Club Liquor License. If successful all alcohol must be contained within the Clubhouse, and no outside alcohol would be allowed anywhere on Club property, including rentals, per the MLCC rules and regulations.
- Proposed By-Law changes will be voted on at the March 13, 2007 G.M.M.
- HPSA 2006 Member of the Year and Long-Term Distinguished Member will be recognized at the March G.M.M.

Board Meeting

February 16, 2006

- Club Manager committee formed Taylor (chairperson), Czuprenski, Dan Card, Gallagher, DeLoof and Jennett
- Pole Barn Renovation: Don Gallagher (chairperson) Czuprenski, Martz and Lori agreed to assist in developing a scope of the work, drawings and plans and an estimate of pricing (Bathrooms and enclosed patio)
- MUCC District 8 Trap League: Motion to pay for the first and last shoots for adult club members who wish to participate and represent our club and to pay the registration fees for all youth shooters (of our members) who participate in the event, motion carried unanimously.
- MUCC District 8 Trap League: League to begin March 11, 2007, H.P.S.A. to host the shoot on June 3, 2007. Matt Roberts agreed to provide support (4H) to the kitchen on the day of the shoot.
- Thirty two potential members will be interviewed on February 28, 2007 at 7:00 P.M. Venue Directors / Board Members are requested to be in attendance, if possible, to introduce themselves, show support of our potential members and to assist with the interviews.
- NRA Banquet: To be held on April 17, 2007. Motion to purchase one table of ten (10) to represent our club, unanimously approved.
- Scholastic Clay Target Program (SCTP) will hold a meeting at the club on March 7, 2007 at 6:00 P.M.
- Scholastic Clay Target Program (SCTP) will be shooting on Wednesday night at regular youth club rates (\$2.00 per round plus the usual environmental assessment).
- Benefit 4 Kids: June 8, 9 and 10, 2007. All club venues will be open for member and public shooting on those dates.
- Sporting Clays: Motion to place an order for five (5) controllers immediately, expending \$1,000 immediately and the balance paid by April 1, 2007 if the supplier agrees, carried, one opposed.
- Sporting Clays Discussion moved to the purchase of golf carts. The board agreed that we could not entertain further consideration of carts until a separate proposal, detailing expenses and income was received.
- Trap: Taylor discussed the need for additional controllers on the trap field to assure proper function. Details forthcoming
- Kitchen Service: A request was received from Jennifer Jodway to provide kitchen services on the weekends. Tabled at this time, awaiting further investigation and details of the offer.
- Dues: Dues are due May 1, 2007. DeLoof will be mailing dues statement in the near future. New membership cards will be ordered. Senior discount was again discussed. Deputat and DeLoof reported that DSC provides a discount and that their regular membership is significantly higher than ours. Motion not to offer senior discounts other than those that currently are provided by way of Green and Gold Memberships as described in the Bylaws. unanimously approved

Proposed By-Law changes, scheduled for membership vote at the March 13, 2007 General Membership Meeting

- 1- Art: III, Part:1, Pg:2, Sec:3 = **FOR**, allows for new member installation if a By-Laws committee doesn't exist.
- 2 - Art: IV, Pg:10, Sec:9 = **FOR**, Changes installation of Officers from January to December GMM.
- 3 - Art: V, Pg:11, Sec:1 = **AGAINST**, proposal to allow alternate Board members to vote in the absence of any director at Board meetings. We have not experienced any problem establishing a quorum in past meetings. Alternates are not voting members of the Board and are not required to attend any BOD meetings, current Directors do not want someone voting in their place.
- 4 - Art: V, Pg:11, Sec:3 = **FOR**, Condenses words and meaning remains the same.
- 5 - Art: VII, Pg:15, Sec:2 = **FOR**, addresses a By-Laws infraction committed by a member of the By-Laws committee, would be reviewed by the Executive Board and not the By-Laws committee.
- 6 - Art: XI, Pg:19, Sec:1 = **AGAINST**, New By-Law prohibiting alcohol on any ranges, This is already a Club rule and state law. By-Laws infractions require formal action for the By-Laws committee and the Board of Directors. Club Rules can be addressed less formally and resolved immediately without written protests and formal review meeting and discipline action.
- 7 - Art: XI, Pg:19, Sec:2 = **AGAINST**, New By-Law to ban smoking in the Clubhouse before, during and after all meetings, dinners and events. We already have a Club Rule banning smoking during the GMM and again breaking a By-Law requires formal action rather than immediate action to correct the current situation.
- 8 - Art: XI, Pg:19, Sec:3 = **AGAINST**, New By-Law to require all HPSA members to also become NRA members which would increase annual dues to cover this cost.
- 9 - Art: XI, Pg:19, Sec:4 = **FOR**, New By-Law that states " No employee, independent contractor, or any person getting paid for their services at H.P.S.A. shall be a member of the Board of Directors.
