1. Bylaw changes will be voted upon at the September General Membership Meeting.
2. Shooting rate increases for non-members will increase \$1.00 beginning September 1, 2007 AND the current discount extended to MUCC members (who are not members of HPSA) will terminate the same date.
3. Dues increases will become effective May 1, 2008 and the proposed \$37.50 assessment which was to be levied September 1, 2007 has been eliminated.
4. A skeet league will begin 9-12-07 and go for 8 weeks. Fifty targets, \$10.00 plus \$1.00 environmental fee. See Mark Taylor for more details.
5. HPSA will be joining the Michigan Sporting Clay Association and the National Sporting Clay Association to become eligible to hold registered shoots.

## Sporting Clays

Sporting Clays is in need of volunteers willing to work on a regular basis to keep the course running. The commitments can be variable and in small amounts depending upon the jobs. For example:

**Battery Maintenance:** 2 hours every other week - this would entail changing half of the courses batteries (14 one week and 12 on the other) - one or two person job

**Closing Sporting Clays:** 2 hours daily loading the target machines and shutting them down for the evening - this job needs to be done at 5:00P on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays (even one day a month per person would be great) - one or two person job

**Target Bin Refills:** 2 hours every other week - this involves using the Kubota to move targets from the storage trailer to the on-course storage bins

**Cleaning Stations:** 1/2 hour per station (pick a few) every other week- this includes trash and hull removal from each shooting station and transporting the garbage (in the green cans) to the dumpsters; stations are limited so call soon

All workers will receive training and flexible schedules can be accommodated. By splitting up the responsibilities it becomes easier to accomplish the many tasks that need to be done to maintain the course. These jobs function along with the workers already running the course for the day, the goal is to keep the workers running the course focused on the daily activities instead of routine maintenance that isn't always an immediate issue. There are also openings for a 9:00A-6:00P once per month (pick your day) to run the Sporting Clays Course.
