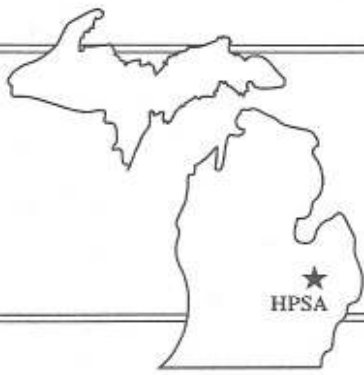

Section 2:

Revenues of the club shall not be used to benefit any member of H.P.S.A. except to further the lawful purposes of the club.

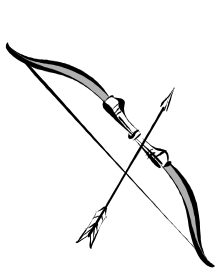
