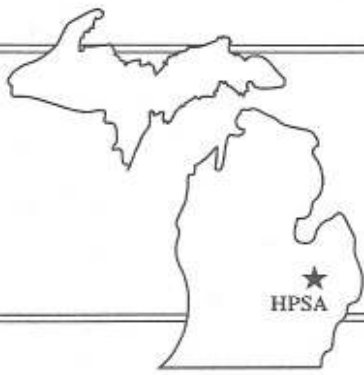

## President's Message

We have been forced to make many changes to our schedule and expenses. Income has dropped significantly and all the special events of the previous months have not produced the anticipated profits to make up for this years increase in expenses. The increased dues did not accomplish our goals either due to members leaving and resulting in basically the same dues income as last year. This has led to the Board of Directors decision to eliminate or reduce expenses as much as possible.

The following outlines what has been decided so far:

1. Trap & Skeet fees will increase to \$4.00 for members, \$6.00 non-members.
2. Punch cards will be eliminated, existing earn cards will be honored until 12/31/08.
3. Open shooting on Wednesday, Friday, Saturday & Sunday, leagues may be scheduled on any day but Thursday, (if enough volunteer help is available).
4. All Board members will pay a special assessment of \$50.
5. Eliminate clubs dial-up internet connection, (not WEB site).
6. Newsletter will be published every other month, (quarterly if further cuts are required).
7. Eliminate meal at all Board meetings.
8. Implement use of coin controllers on all Trap & Skeet fields.
9. Ensure all extra clays thrown on Sporting Clays are paid.
10. Institute an inventory control system for clay targets.
11. All events, leagues, etc. will be required to only purchase what is needed for that event, (no volume purchasing), and provide detailed reporting of income & expenses.
12. Add a 4% charge to all reloading component orders to cover shipping costs.
13. Additional areas that will be evaluated for reduction are; electric bills, grounds maintenance expenses, fuel bills, Sunday Breakfast expenses, clays costs, etc.
