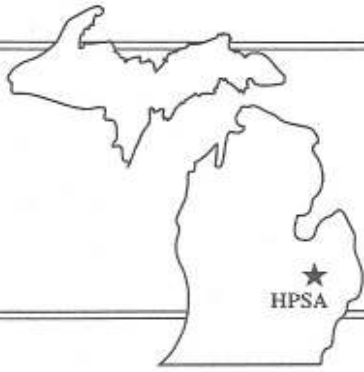

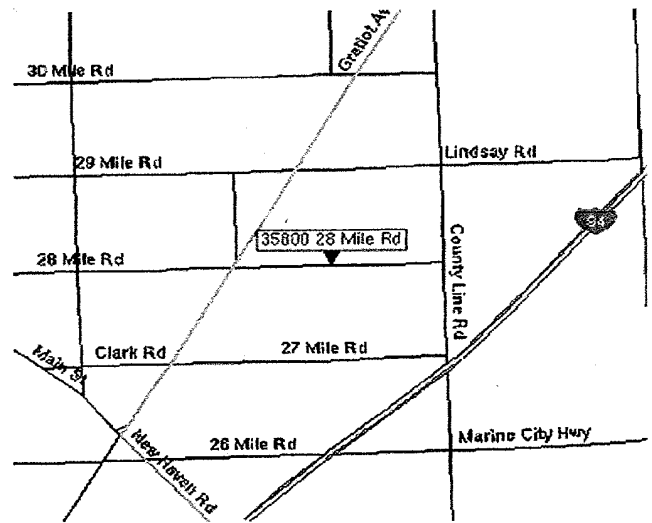

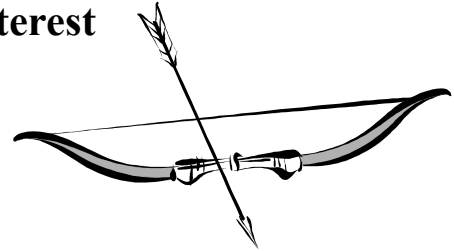

## SCTP at Huron Pointe

Huron Pointe's SCTP members competed in the 2008 National Championships in Sparta, Illinois.

There were 130 Registered Teams in the Senior Varsity Division; because of ties (multiples with the same score), there are 82 places. **The Huron Pointe Sportsmen's Association's** Senior Varsity Team place 40th in their division overall (last year they were in 52nd place).

They are the **1st place squad from Michigan's Participants (935 of 1000 targets)**. We have 4 of the top 10 individual scores from Michigan based on 200 targets. (#3. Geno Salvatore 194 / #4 [tied] Mike Sintebin - 192 / #5 [tied] Clarence Van Camp - 191 / #6. Matt Hines - 190). Ben Wallace score a 168 (not bad for a first time shootin' at Nationals).

Our Intermediate Entry Level shooters did very well. Matt Davis shot a 143 of 200 & Tyler Lee Shot a 91. This was both boys first time at the National. They shot on an alternate squad with two (Rookie Division) shooters from St Joseph County and the 4 shooters turned in a score 501 of 1000.

We have just been notified we have 3 shooters that have qualified for the Junior Olympic Shooting Competition in Colorado Springs, CO on August 23-25. Clarence Van Camp (116 of 125), Ben Wallace (100), and Matt Hines (100) have received invitations.
