Youth Archery Tune-up and IBEP

June 23 to August 18, 2011 (No July 14th) - Thursdays from 5:30 to 7:30PM

Would you like to practice bowhunting before the archery season sets in? Would you like to get your IBEP certificate as well? Want a way to try out your new bow? Want to spend time with your child in the outdoors? Does the parent also want an IBEP certificate?

This course will follow the IBEP (International Bowhunting Education Program) curriculum. IBEP certificates are necessary for hunting with a bow out West and in certain Canadian Provinces. Participants will have hands on learning of shot placements, judging distances, tree stand and ground blind safety, tracking, hunting etiquette, wildlife identification and outdoor preparedness. After the informational class each day, you will be going out on the 3D course. What a way to spend a great summer evening! At the end of the course, there will be a “test your knowledge” 3D run and the optional IBEP test. If the child, or parent, is to obtain his/her IBEP certificate/card, he/she must attend all sessions.

The cost will be \$7.00 per participant per week (to cover the cost of 3D core replacement) with parent shooting free. There is a \$10.00 (one-time) fee to cover the cost of books. We will be going out rain or shine, dress appropriately for the weather. Bring your quiver, arrows, bow and other archery equipment for the first day of class! Bow rental is available for a nominal fee from HPSA.
