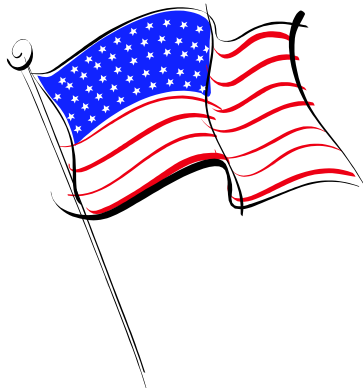

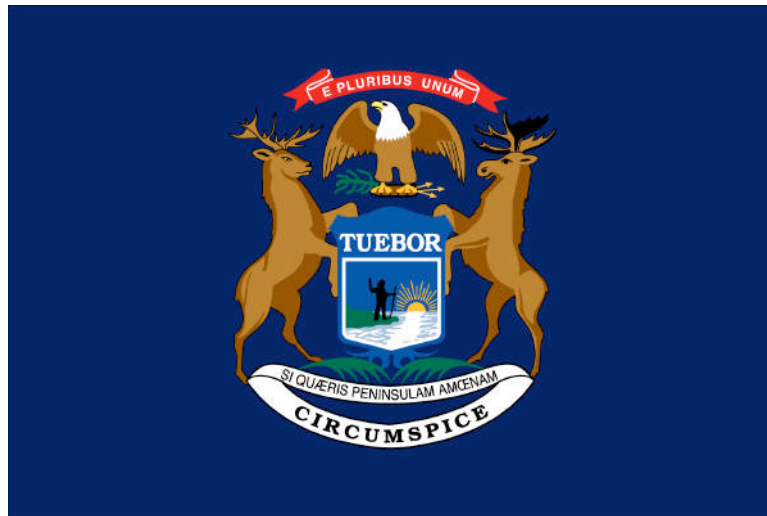

Section I: Member and Guest Conduct/Responsibilities

§ I.1: All members and guests shall conduct themselves in an orderly and respectful manner toward other members and guests at all times.

§ I.2: Audible inappropriate language is not acceptable.

§ I.3: All minor children must be accompanied by an adult regardless of said parties location within the facility and/or club grounds.

§ I.4: All members and guests are responsible for picking up after themselves, maintaining a clean facility and grounds.

Section II: General Membership Meetings

§ II.1: No smoking will be allowed in the clubhouse at any time.

§ II.1: Members shall treat each other in kind, abstaining from derogatory and demeaning remarks.

Section III: Club House

§ III.1: No one under twenty-one years of age shall be allowed at the bar (i.e. behind or seated).

§ III.2: All personal use of facilities must be approved by the BOD (i.e. clubhouse rental, pavilion rental, etc).

§ III.3: No dogs or animals of any kind will be allowed in the Clubhouse with the exception of service animals.

Section IV: Club Grounds

§ IV.1: Parking lot and driveway speed limit is 10 mph.

§ IV.2: Any use of motorized utility/recreational vehicles are strictly limited to the sporting clays course, loading targets and club business ((Warning: racing on the grounds with any vehicle (i.e. ATVs, motorcycles, go-carts, etc.) is prohibited).

§ IV.3: Loitering on club property during non-operating hours, which includes members, their families or friends will not be tolerated.

§ IV.4: No hunting is allowed on HPSA property.

§ IV.4a: exception to rule IV.4, only allowed in the advent of a club sponsored hunt (i.e. deer hunt, etc.) approved by the board.

Section V: Rifle/Pistol Range

§ V.1: Eye and Ear protection is mandatory for all shooters and spectators.

§ V.2: No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the range.

§ V.3: Use of cell phones are prohibited in so far as they become disruptive and compromise safety. Preferably, cell phones should be turned off or set to vibration mode.

§ V.4: Upon instruction from the Range Safety Officer, all firearms will be unloaded and the actions left open. Live fire may ONLY! commence upon the instruction of the Range Safety Officer.

§ V.5: All shooters are required to pick up spent shell casings prior to leaving the range.

§ V.6: All shooters must follow the rules established in the rifle range SOP.

Section VI: Trap/Skeet Range

§ VI.1: Eye and Ear protection is mandatory for all shooters and spectators.

§ VI.2: No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the range.

§ VI.3: Use of cell phones are prohibited in so far as they become disruptive and compromise safety. Preferably, cell phones should be turned off or set to vibration mode.

§ VI.4: All non-participating children must be accompanied by an adult and remain BEHIND the firing line.

§ VI.5: All shooters are required to pick up spent shot shell hulls prior to leaving the range.

§ VI.6: All shot shells should be target loads; hunting loads are prohibited.

Section VII: Sporting Clays Course

§ VII.1: Eye and Ear protection is mandatory for all shooters and spectators.

§ VII.2: No alcoholic beverages will be permitted on the range.

§ VII.3: **Non-alcoholic beverages** may be carried on the sporting clay course in a metal or plastic type containers. Glass is prohibited.

§ VII.4: Use of cell phones are prohibited in so far as they become disruptive and compromise safety. Preferably, cell phones should be turned off or set to vibration mode.

§ VII.5: All non-participating children on the sporting clays course must be seated at the stations during all shooting and accompanied by an adult.

§ VII.6: All shooters are required to pick up spent shot shell hulls prior to leaving the course.

§ VII.7: All shot shells should be target loads; hunting loads are prohibited.

Section VIII: 3-D Archery Course

§ VIII.1: **Non-alcoholic beverages** may be carried on the 3-D Archery course in a metal or plastic type containers. Glass is prohibited.

§ VIII.2: All members and guests shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner. See Section I.

Section IX: Indoor Archery

§ IX.1: League rules must be followed at all times.

§ IX.2: All members and guests shall conduct themselves in an orderly manner. See Section I.
