Youth Shotgun Program:

The Youth Shotgun Program is in full practice and competition. Monday nights have been busy with 50 to 60 youth shooters attending and shooting practice rounds. We have also added Wednesday nights with Coach Forbert from 4:00-6:00pm.

Michigan High School Clay Target registration closed on the 29th of March for new and returning shooters. Anchor Bay has 19 members and L'Anse Creuse-North has 14 members. Many of them are new to the teams; but, are showing real promise.

ATA-AIM: Our first competition will be at Birmingham Gun Club on April 25th, with many more to follow if Covid-19 restrictions will allow shoots this year. We have 11 registered AIM shooters with another 4 possible shooters as of Monday March 28th.

USA Shooting Junior Olympics: The State shoot is in May at Hillsdale. We have a few shooters interested trying Bunker and competing this year. We will be practicing Wobble Trap at Gilbert's Gun Club on Thursdays starting April 8th, start time 6:00pm.
