Fall 2018 Hunters Education Class

Huron Pointe's Education Class is scheduled for:

Wednesday August 15 (5:30PM-9:30PM),
Thursday August 16 (6:00PM-9:30PM) and
Saturday August 18 (8:00AM-4:00PM), 2018

No pre-registration for 3-day class, register at the door at the Wednesday class. Fees are \$10.00 per student and all three (3) classes must be attended for certification. This course is recommended for children over 12 and provides hands on teaching for individuals unfamiliar with firearms, outdoor safety and hunting practices.

Online/Field Day Students must pre-register and present their completed online certification to the Saturday class at 7:30AM. There is an online course fee (typically \$25.00 - paid online) and a \$10 fee to participate in the "Field Day" portion at Huron Pointe.

If the student has special needs please let us know in advance so that we may accommodate you. No student will be turned away. The Saturday class will be outdoors, please dress for the weather. The DNR exam is required for both classes, assistance will be available if needed.

Snacks will be available on Wednesday & Thursday for a small fee; lunch will be provided on Saturday.
