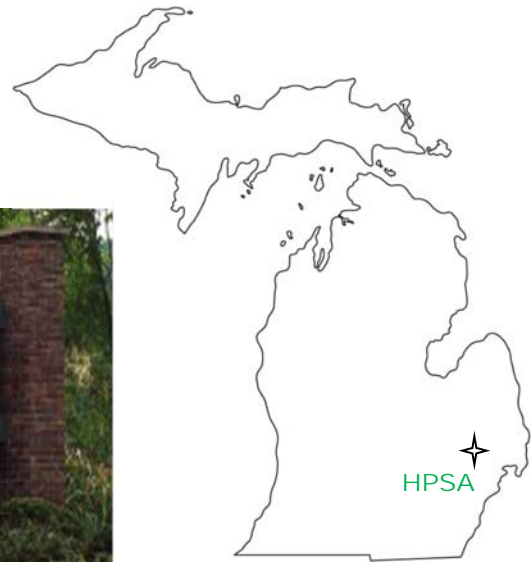

On June 15th our high School Team shooters shot the Michigan Clay Target High School League state shoot at Mason, Michigan. We had 17 from Anchor Bay and 10 from L'Anse Creuse-North. Many of the shooters accomplished new personal best scores and some struggled a bit.

**We have 3 All-State Team members: LC-N shooters Mitch Warner and Brayden Ingles/ AB shooter Joe Lietke**

**LC-N also brought home the top Novice Male-Dylan Wofford and top female Novice-Erin Koscielski**

We are now working to get ready for the High School National's on July 11-14. It will be held at the Michigan Trapshooting Home Grounds in Mason, Michigan. Both Schools have a 5 member and some of the youth are shooting individual as well.

## **AIM News:**

We had 23 youth shoot the Michigan State Zone 4 shoot at Richmond Sportsman's Club on June 22 & 23. On Saturday, June 22 the kids shoot Singles, Handicap & Doubles. **Thomas Gunst is the Junior Singles Champion /Brayden Ingles is the Handicap-Runner up Champion** (he tied for second place and had to win a shoot off against an adult to take it)
