Hold Harmless Registration and Check-In Procedure

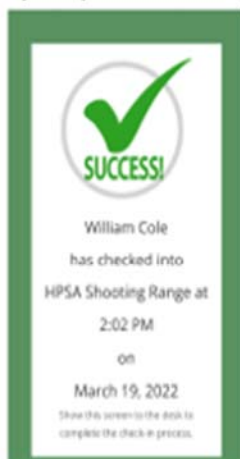
Hold Harmless registration and check-in can take place using a smart phone or the kiosk at the front desk. The preferable method is to use a smart phone. A kiosk is available for those who do not have a smart phone.

Hold Harmless Registration and Check-In using Smart Phone

1. Open the Camera app on your phone.
2. Point your camera at the QR code displayed at the Front Desk.



3. Tap the link when prompted.
4. You will be directed to the Range Check-In where you enter your phone number.
5. If there is a Hold Harmless form registered for that phone number, click the Check-In button to begin the Check-In process in Step 8 below.
6. If there is no Hold Harmless form registered for that phone number, you will first be asked to "Complete Hold Harmless Form."
7. Once you have entered the required information to associate your phone number with a registered Hold Harmless form, you can click the Check-In button to begin the Check-In process.
8. You will receive a text message on your phone containing a link to confirm your request to Check-In at Huron Pointe. Tap the link to confirm and you will receive the success message on your phone which you will present to the Front Desk attendant to finish the Check-In process.



9. At this point you are registered and checked-in. When visiting the club in the future you can follow steps 1 through 5 and step 8 using your smart phone to Check-In.

The Youth Shotgun Program : As May and June come into focus the kids are very busy competing and getting ready for State and Nationals.

High School's Clay Target League: According to the Michigan Clay Target official announcement the League has 80 High Schools this year in Michigan. They have divided the shooters into 11 conferences, Anchor Bay with 15 members is in Conference 5 and L'Anse Creuse North with 12 members is in Conference 3. True competition started on April 11 and will continue through May 17th. The State Shoot is to be held on June 18th at the Michigan Trapshooting Home grounds in Mason, Michigan. Most of our shooters are improving at a vary good pace, but, as always some are struggling a little but they are having fun and want to continue.

AIM: Our AIM shooters will have completed their first ATA competition on April 24th at Birmingham Gun Club, by the time you read this, and be looking forward to the Spring Team Shoot at Mason on May 1st. May and June will be very busy for these shooters, we hope to continue to improve and score well at the AIM State Shoot in July.

Waiver Shooters: These youngsters are our future. These shooters are our Non-competitive shooters. They are learning what trap is all about and just shooting for fun. The smiles that come as they feel more confident is awesome to watch. They come in shy and reserved and then all of a sudden they hit a few targets and they can't wait to tell someone how well they did with a big grin on their faces.
