Range Safety Officer Program Modifications

The rifle range has had a great year so far and has contributed significantly to our club, I am extremely happy with the many who volunteered their time and labor to Improve our operations. A huge thank you to all.

In the spirit of continuous improvement, we need to catch up on a few things: Range access and use during the week, the legal implications of maintaining RSO certifications thru the NRA and the fair extension of the range privileges to those who sacrifice their family time to supervise and improve the range.

First, Range access has gotten a little confused. RSOs have the privileges of using the range off-hours and the responsibility of doing so safely. Tidiness has also been an issue and we have had no real accountability.

Second, all those who open and supervise the range have to be certified as an RSO through the National Rifle Association. This will play a big role in any potential accident investigation and we have to keep current.

Finally, we need to update the RSO list, remove non-working RSOs and re-align those who can only work part time or have a disabilities/other issues.

A wise man once said "If you have enough problems, they can sometime solve each other" In that vein, we will have an RSO meeting on December 10th at 7PM in the club house. All RSOs will need to have proof of their CURRENT RSO Certification by that date also RSOs will be assigned to either Active, Reserved/Retired or Inactive Status. New numbered range keys will be issued to Active RSOs. Only Active RSOs will be allowed to open and run the rifle range going forward...Non-Active RSOs may assist the active RSOs. For those without computer support or the knowledge of how to obtain your certificate, I will have a computer and printer at the meeting.
