

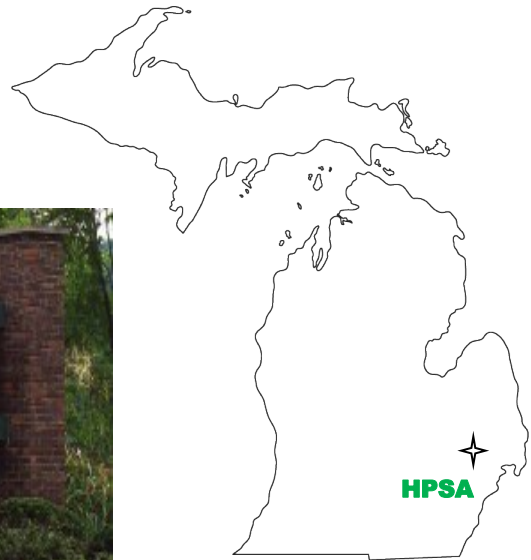

At our October GMM a member asked about the Club's Liability Insurance. I gave a general answer that somehow was interpreted that we do not have liability insurance. Let me assure everyone we

have a \$1 million commercial general liability policy and an additional \$1 million umbrella that covers all volunteer workers while performing duties related to the conduct of our business. We also have insurance that co-

vers the replacement of all our buildings and assets up to \$1.2 million, \$1 million liquor liability, \$1 million Director's & Officers and \$1 million auto. I have invited our insurance agent to our next Board meeting to address questions and discuss our renewal package.
